

Creation of our Mission Statement

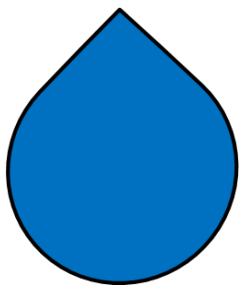
The children, parents, staff and Governors have all worked together to design an image that will present our Mission Statement in an accessible and child friendly way.

The soil from which everything grows

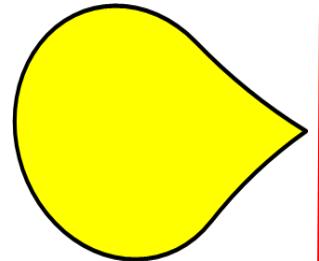
By following our Mission Statement, we will see four clear signs within our school community.
