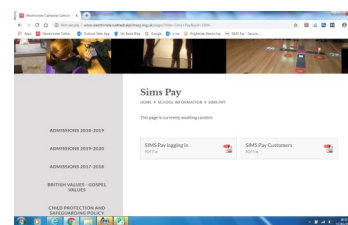
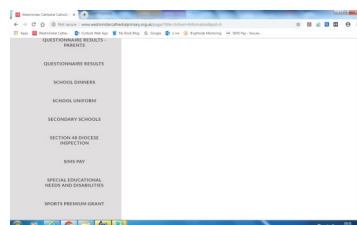


We invite you to celebrate Mass in school this Wednesday, 22nd May for the Ascension. The Mass is in school at 9.30am.
