Riding a scooter or bike to school

It has come to my attention that some of our pupils are travelling to school on a scooter or a bike in **an unsafe manner**.

This morning I received a complaint from a member of the public who has said that she walks past our school each morning and has been hit a number of times by pupils from our school riding their scooter.

She has observed how pupils are allowed to ride ahead of their parent/ carer and she has been worried about the safety of a number of pupils as they ride their scooter.

We have and will continue to educate the pupils in school about road awareness and we ask you to do the same at home.

If you choose for your child to travel to school using a scooter or a bicycle that you are confident that they can ride them safely and that they are wearing the right equipment. I also ask that you help teach your children about being aware of pedestrians who are also sharing the pavement.

Please make the children be aware of the public and be respectful to them sharing the pavement.

Thank you in advance for supporting your children and making them aware of their own safety and the safety of others.
