Maths focus

Learn your multiplications up to 12x12, all of them off by heart.

You can create posters or get practice questions online. Some maths skills to practise/ revise:

- count backwards through zero to include negative numbers
- I can read Roman numerals to 100 (I to C)
- recognise and show using diagrams families of common equivalent fractions
- add and subtract fractions with the same denominator
- I can read, write and convert time between analogue and digital 12- clocks
- I can read, write and convert time between analogue and digital 24 hour clocks

Science focus:

Create a project all about the **water cycle**.

This will be put up on display in the classroom.

NC objective:

“identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.”

Topic focus:

Tudors- Geography: Use maps to identify British colonies around the world and countries that formed the British Empire and the Commonwealth during the Tudor times.

New topic- Food and farming around the World

History: Research changing food habits over the last 100 years in Britain. Experience foods from different time periods.

Geography: Use maps to locate continents, countries and oceans. Research food and farming around the world.

Art: Use a range of sketching and drawing techniques to draw fruits and vegetables. Use sketches to create faces in the style of Arcimboldo.

English focus:

Writing:

We have been focussing on writing narratives.

Become an author and write your own book!
Be creative, make a front and back cover.

Grammar focus:

Learn about and use stylistic devices such as alliteration, onomatopoeia and similes to add effect to narrative writing

Handwriting focus:

Use the diagonal and horizontal strokes that are needed to join letters and understand which letters, when adjacent to one another, are best left un-joined

Spanish focus:

Draw weather forecast maps and label in Spanish the weather forecast for the UK, Europe or around the world.

RE focus:

Read and re-tell the Easter Story.

- Write a diary entry for each day
- Make stained glass windows for some of the stations of the cross
- Create a 3-D tomb with some written information
