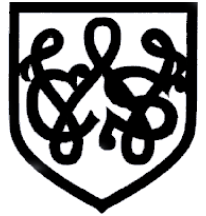


Westminster Cathedral Roman Catholic Primary School

Dear children and parents at Westminster Cathedral Primary School,

I am writing to inform you that I will be leaving Westminster Cathedral Primary School at the end of this academic year (August 2020).

I have thought and prayed a lot about this decision and I am very sad to be leaving you all. I am not going to another school nor do I currently have another job to go to. In September I will be spending time with my family and my parents making sure they are well.

Our school's governing body have worked closely with the diocese and the local authority to recruit my replacement. It has been agreed that Mr Scott-Cree, the current headteacher of St Vincent de Paul Primary School, Westminster will become the executive headteacher of both schools starting in the Autumn term. The existing members of the senior leadership team will take on some of my current responsibilities. This exciting challenge will offer lots of opportunities for future collaboration between both schools. The executive head model is being used in many schools across London and I will be having a comprehensive handover to Mr Scott-Cree.

It has been an absolute pleasure leading our school these past 4 years and working at WCPS since 2008. I would like to thank you and your families for making every day a pleasure coming into work. I would like to thank the staff for their support and hard work. As a school community we have achieved an incredible amount these past four years of which I am immensely proud. I know the staff will continue to give all they can under the leadership of the new executive headteacher to ensure WCPS continues to provide the best learning opportunities for you, the children and parents at Westminster Cathedral Primary School.

I hope and pray that I will be able to see you before the end of July, but we must keep following the Government guidelines. Please know I am fully committed to continue to serve you, your families and the community at WCPS until my last day and you will remain in my thoughts and prayers.
